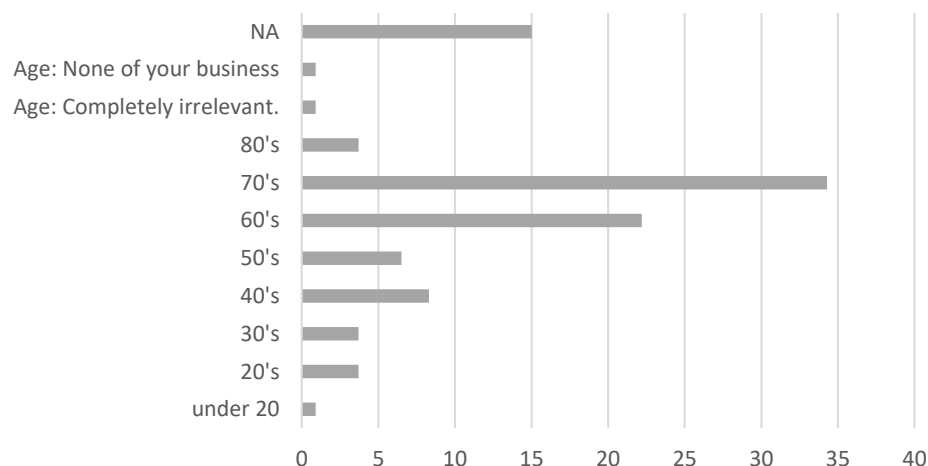
Background

- Why did we run the survey?
 - Capacity and funding in place
 - We needed community feedback on project ideas so we were focused on what the community wanted
- June to July 15 – sent out our initial list of ideas and asked for more
- July – consolidated ideas into groupings that corresponded to City of Kelowna department areas because we will HAVE TO work with the City on the vast majority of the wish list
- July to September – ran the Community Wish List Survey

Outcomes ... are statistically significant!

- 108 surveys – this represents 11.25% of all households in Quail Ridge
- Pretty good representation across age cohorts

Percentages of Age Cohorts in Quail Ridge



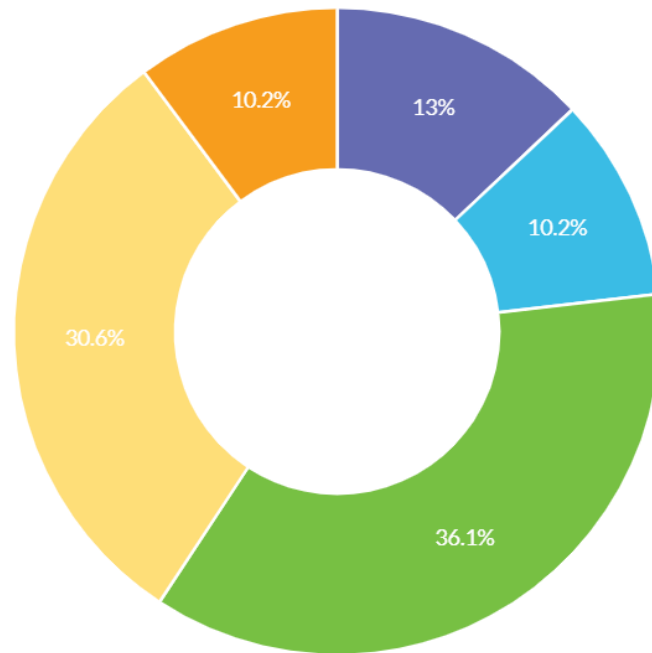

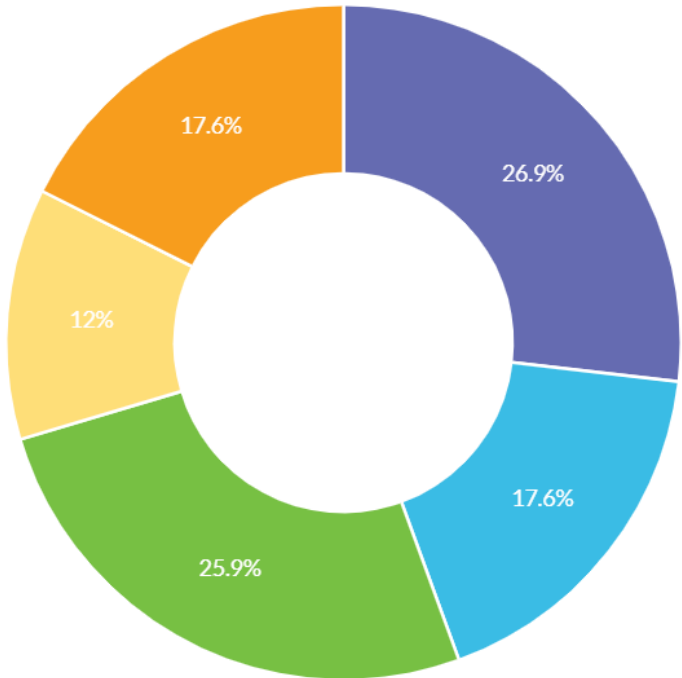

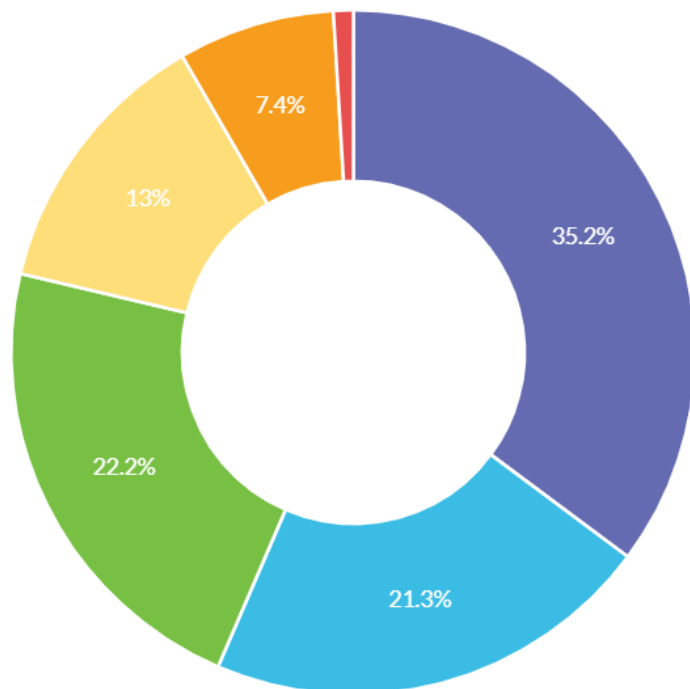

Update the entrance to the linear park trails with park benches and a water fountain	12
Add a washroom somewhere along the linear trails	12
Update the Quail Park Place. The children's play structures are very old and picnic tables would be great ... or clear additional space and adding outdoor fitness equipment like the equipment at Parkinson Rec Centre	29
Conduct a FireSmart cleanup of the linear park trails and add Firesafe signage	21
Work with community partners, such as Okanagan Golf Course and UBCO, to conduct larger FireSmart cleanups in our bordering area (excluding the linear trails)	34



Choice	Total
Approach the City to figure out how to get drivers to slow down on our roads. We had a lot of people write with suggestions such as adding more 50 km painted signage on the roadways, speed bumps, speed dips, speed reduction barriers, larger stop signs, etc.	37
Approach BC Transit and the City to improve the bus stops areas with benches or shelters or bike parking and discussing the possibility of weekend service in our area.	23
Approach various service providers to see if there is a way to improve cell coverage	32
Approach the Airport and the City to improve connections with the airport to better understand the changes that the community is witnessed, such as the increase in private aircraft and helicopters that fly low over Quail Ridge (i.e. fear of crashes, noise pollution, etc.)	14

Next Steps...

- Caveat: We can't guarantee that any of these ideas are actionable.
- Will start discussions with City of Kelowna about traffic, working with UBCO and Okanagan Golf course about FireSmart initiatives
- Will continue working on community bulletin boards
- Have already started talking with City about community entrance and pickle ball and tennis courts!
- Manage expectations: For City projects, expect that this will entail future City of Kelowna surveys and community involvement
